## DGE Young Scientist Symposium

COVID-19 has significantly reduced opportunities for young scientists to present their work on workshops and conferences and thus reduces career chances. By introducing online "DGE Young Scientist Symposia", the DGE intends to provide opportunities for young scientists to present excellent work in the field of electron microscopy performed during a PhD thesis. Symposia are planned to take place regularly, where up to three talks of young scientists are presented to the DGE community. The 30 min talks can be from material science, life science as well as from instrumentation and methods.

The third online DGE Young Scientist Symposium will take place on  
Thursday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022 from 14:00 to 16:00.

Young scientists are eligible to present their work up to about one year after successful graduation from a PhD. Applications of young scientists or suggestions from PhD advisors should contain a summary of the PhD thesis, a CV of the young scientist and a supporting letter from the PhD advisor.
